Here are some choices of some creative homework we'd like you to complete at home.

You can choose to do just one or complete as many as you'd like.



<p>Draw and colour an animal of your choice. Label it's body parts and features.</p>	<p>Design a brand-new animal! Perhaps you could mix two animals together! Paint or draw it. Then write a sentence to describe it. What noise will it make? Where will it live?</p>	<p>Find a stone and paint it to look like a spotty or stripy animal or bug. Or.... Make a model of an animal using Lego, junk modelling, clay or play dough.</p>
<p>Can you think of and write 3 words to rhyme with each of these? Pig, hen cat, dog, goat, sheep</p>	<p>Be a farmer! Plant your own seed. Every few days measure the shoot and draw the changes. What seed will you plant?</p>	<p>Go on a bug hunt! Draw and label what you find!</p>
<p>Choose your favourite animal story. Can you retell it to someone in your family in your own words? Try to use different voices fir the characters.</p>	<p>Sing 'Old Macdonald.' Choose an animal and write your own verse for the song!</p>	<p>Read the story of the Little Red Hen. Could you make something using flour? What other ingredients will you need? Take photographs of your creations and perhaps write the list of ingredients you used.</p>
