

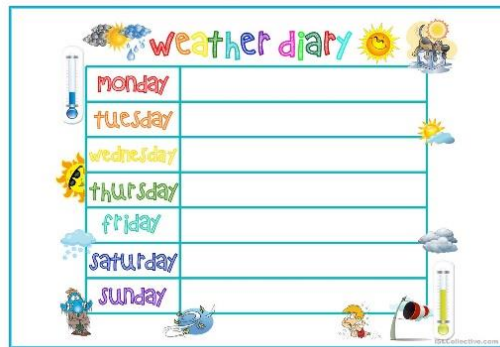


# 'You are my sunshine'-Home Learning

Go on a scavenger hunt. Have a competition with someone in your house and see who can find all the things on the list first.

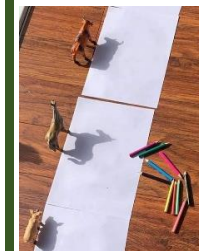


Investigating symmetry – what things in your garden
