



Easter Eggstravaganza- Home Learning



Here are some activities for you to do at home

You can choose to do just one or complete as many as you'd like.

Make some Easter treats to share with your family! You could make biscuits or cakes.



Make an Easter basket to keep your treats in. You could use empty cardboard boxes and add decorations too!



Decorate some hard-boiled eggs. You could use pens or paint and add some extra decorations such as stickers, feathers or googly eyes!

Or just design your own Easter Egg using pens, pencils and paper.

Make a few pom-poms (see next page) and then make some little chicks



Plant some seeds and keep looking out for changes. The weather has been good so you should see things happening soon!

Read or watch the story of Chicken Licken. Can you retell the story in your own words to someone in your family? Try to use different voices for each of the characters.

The easiest way to make pompoms!

There are many ways to make pompoms but this is by far the simplest and fastest method I have come across. All you need is a fork, some yarn, and a pair of scissors.

1. You'll need some yarn, a fork, and a pair of scissors.



2. Lay a short length of yarn between the middle tines of the fork as shown. (This will be used to tie the pom-pom.)

3. Start wrapping the ball of yarn around the fork tines. Hold the short piece of yarn against the handle of the fork to keep it out of the way.



4. Continue wrapping 50-60 times around, then cut off the end of the yarn.



5. Next, wrap the short piece of yarn tightly around the centre of the bundle, pull tight, and tie a square knot.

6. Slide the bundle off the fork.

7. Carefully cut each loop. (This step will take adult help.)

8. When you have completed the cutting, your pom-pom will look rather scruffy. Give it a "hair cut" and trim to a nice round shape.

9. Rub the pom-pom between your palms to fluff it up!

10. Stick two pom-poms together, add a beak and eyes and you have a chick!
