- Staff Leavers: We were very sad to say goodbye to Miss Slade our ELSA support on Tuesday. She has worked with children who need that extra emotional support since September 2018, and is moving on to further her career.
- Literacy: Last week, children came home with a 'Reading for Pleasure' booklet. This is a guide to books that are recommended for their age group and books that we currently have in our school library. We will no longer be providing a 'click and collect' service instead your child will be visiting the library with their class teacher. Please look after these books.

We now also have year 6 children who have been selected to be a school librarian and are currently familiarizing themselves with the library. They will be available at playtimes to help children change books.

We are excited to announce that we are taking part in the Henley Literary Festival in October. Every class will be virtually streaming into a live session with a famous children's author. This is a fabulous opportunity for children to meet a real author and take part in various activities.
