WHERE WILL YOUR DONATIONS GO....?

We were thrilled to fund our first big project since our committee was set up in early 2022. The new playground markings were entirely funded by FOWS at a cost of £4,500 and we are really pleased with the results! We are so grateful to everyone who has donated or volunteered to make this project happen.

We have committed to raising £10,000 this year to replace the school minibus which is shared with 2 other schools.

We have raised around £2,300 so far with the disco, match funding and other donations, we expect to have raised £4,000 - £5,000 by the end of the summer term and we already have some fun ideas for the Autumn Term.

We can't raise the amount needed through events alone and have submitted grant applications to help fund the rest but match funding is key to meeting our target. If you can help with grant applications or are able to Match Fund, please get in touch.
