- Illness/Absence: Please leave a message on the absence line with a reason for absence by 10am latest, for our records, and update us on a daily basis. Should the child or any family member be isolating due to Covid, we politely ask for sight of a test result prior to the child returning.
- Car Engines: In this cold weather, it is tempting to keep your engines idling whilst waiting in your car during drop off and pick up. However, this is detrimental to the health of young children who are regularly exposed to exhaust fumes. It is also illegal and can result in a £20 fine if you refuse to switch your engine off when asked to do so by an authorised person.
- **Parking:** We understand that parking near to school is always an issue. Shaw Social club has very kindly allowed us to have temporary use of their car park during parent drop off and pick up times. This has been reviewed and will continue for a while into the Spring term. It helps everyone if you could observe an unofficial one-way system, entering Maple Crescent from the Shaw Social Club end, at pick up and drop off times.
