- Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebration: This coming Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> May, we will be celebrating the jubilee by inviting children and staff to wear something red, white and blue. If your child would like one, please pre-order so that the kitchen can prepare in good time.
- **Ouadkids Competition:** Tomorrow morning a team of key stage 2 pupils are representing the school at a multi-school athletics competition at Park House. Please wish them luck!
- End of this Half Term: Please remember that our last day of this half term is FRIDAY 27th. We will finish at the usual time. (This date does differ from some other schools). The new term starts on Monday 6th June.
- Lost Property: We have lots of jumpers, cardigans, water bottles etc. with illegible or no names on them being brought to the office every day. Unless we can read a name we cannot return the item to its owner, so PLEASE make sure everything is clearly named. #### **Upcoming Trips & Events:**

- Speech & Language Resource (SAL) Trip: The children in the resource will be travelling by minibus to Wellington Country park for a day out on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June. Payments are on School Money.
- Year 4 Overnight Trip to Rushall Farm: We are excited to be able to take Year 4 camping at nearby Rushall Farm. We leave in the morning of Monday 6th June and return on Tuesday 7th afternoon. The last installment of £20 is due by TODAY. If you have not already done so, please complete and return the medical and consent form.
- Year 5 Bikeability: We have 2 dates in June for Year 5 to have the opportunity to do Level 1 Bikeability training. For the first time, this will incur a cost of £10 which includes the follow on level 2 training in Year 6. The Community Furniture Project based in Newbury can offer bikes to children that require them if they attend a West Berkshire School (these bikes are fully checked and roadworthy). Parents can go along to the warehouse on Hambridge Road Industrial Estate, Bone Lane, Newbury RG14 5SS to check their available stock. They are a charity so we would suggest a donation is offered. If your child is entitled to free school meals and would like to take part in training but doesn't have a bike, please contact the school office for more information about how we can help.

- Year 5 Trips to Greenham Common Control Tower: As part of our History work after half term, we will be carrying out a local study based on Greenham Common. We have been lucky enough to secure guided class visits to the Control Tower. We have sent a letter out to parents today with more details. For dates of which class goes when see diary below.
