- School Photographer: A new photographic company, "Creative Klick" is taking individual pupil photos this coming Monday 19<sup>th</sup> October. Due to restrictions on having large groups in one place, we are not taking family photos as we would usually do. We have reviewed arrangements and will now ONLY be taking photos of year 6 children with their siblings in school, as this is the last year they will have a photo taken at Winchcombe. We realise that this is not ideal, but hope you will appreciate the difficulties we face keeping our class bubbles separate and safe. On the day, each child will bring home a card with an individual code for you to access Creative Klick's website and order photos. You will be able to "mix and match" photos within one order which makes it more cost effective. If your child is due to have PE or Forest Adventures on Monday, please send them to school wearing uniform top half (polo shirt and sweatshirt) but still with PE/Forest kit bottom half, thank you.

A carton of juice in the lunch box is acceptable.
