Phonics

In Phonics we have begun to look at digraphs where two letters combine to make one sound. We have looked at the digraphs sh, ch, th and ng and read words with these sounds in. The children have also added the words he, she, me and we to their tricky word bank.

Reading

It is great to see the children making such great progress with their reading and displaying such enthusiasm for book sharing. If you can try to hear your child read every night and record in their diary how much they have read and how they found the text. Please could we ask that the children bring their books to school every day too.

Maths

In Maths, we have been focussing on counting forwards and backwards to five. We have begun to understand, use and investigate the terms more than or less than through number songs including Five Little Speckled Frogs, Five Currant Buns and Five Little Ducks. The children have continued to work on their ability to recognise groups of objects without counting which we call subitising.
