- **Photographs:** We had the photographer in last Thursday and they made a point of telling us how brilliant and well behaved the children were. For those who missed out due to absence, they will be back in school again on the morning of Wednesday 30th November. The photo order cards are coming home today or Monday. They detail how to order and your child's special code. The ordering portal should be ready but please be patient if not.
- **School Dinners:** We have added the rest of the term's dinners to School Money for pre-ordering. You will see on 8th December there will only be picnic bag choices available, because the panto timing on that day causes operational limitations in the kitchen that day. In addition, we request that children order ONLY the picnic bag option on the day that they go to the panto, or bring their own packed lunch, as they will be late back on these mornings.
- Christmas Dinner: This is on Wednesday 14th December. If you usually pay for lunches, the cost is £3. The choice is roast Turkey with trimmings, or a Veggie parcel with veggie sausage and trimmings. Pudding is Ice-cream and shortbread or Christmas crumble and custard. Please log on to Schoolmoney to pre-order by **Thursday 1st December**. This gives the kitchen time to order the food.
- Remembrance Day: on Friday 11th we held a 2-minute silence. Classes made poppies which were put on display on our forecourt gardens. Year 5 visited Parkway to mark the occasion and met some historical war experts. They learnt about the role of the Home Guard and also about communication devices and weapons that were used during the war.
- Year 6 Residential Trip: Thank you to our staff who accompanied and took care of the Year 6 children. They had a truly amazing time and got to try out activities such as canoeing and kayaking, high ropes, low ropes, zip wire, climbing wall and abseiling, shooting and archery.
- Year 4 Roman Day: The children had a great day learning about the ancient Romans and had fun becoming romans for the day, using costumes and props provided by Robbie the Roman.

Upcoming Trips & Events:

- Year 5/6 Bikeability Course: Level 1 takes place tomorrow, Thursday 24th November during the school day. Level 2 takes place in March 2023.
