- World Book Day Short Story Competition Winner! Our local MP Laura Farris recently ran a competition in association with Pearson publishers. She invited children to write a short story of no more than 500 words. We are absolutely delighted to announce that Vinayak in Chestnut class has won his category, with his story. Miss Farris said his story "showed wonderful creativity and originality and he clearly has a strong aptitude for creative writing". Vinayak's prize is a tailored book bundle from Pearson.
- Comic Relief "Funky Hair" Day: In return for a small donation to the Comic Relief charity we have invited children (and staff) to get creative with their hair styles on Friday 19th March. Full uniform must be worn. In school, the children will also be taking part in a challenge to run the 'Daily Mile' route to try and beat professional racing driver and double amputee Billy Monger's 140 mile route. All proceeds will go towards tackling homelessness, hunger, domestic abuse and mental health stigma both in the UK and around the world.
- Year 6 Victorian Day: As part of their topic "Revolution" Year 6 will be dressing up as Victorian school children on Friday 26th March for a Virtual Victorian Schoolroom day delivered by Reading Museum. A donation of £3 is requested – payment and consent is via Schoolmoney.

- Steel Pans: Lessons have re-commenced for Year 5 this Wednesday, including the Year 6 group from 8.20 – 8.50 am.

We understand that parking near to school is always an issue, but PLEASE park considerately towards pedestrians with push-chairs and very young children without blocking driveways, our car park entrance or up on pavements. Shaw Social club has very kindly allowed us to have temporary use of their car park during parent drop off and pick up times. This arrangement is still to be reviewed. It helps everyone if you could observe an unofficial one-way system, entering Maple Crescent from the Shaw Social Club end, at pick up and drop off times. Please note that no turning around, dropping off or parking is allowed in the Staff par park.
