








FoWS survey responses - May 2021

FoWS is applying to become a Registered Charity. The charity is run by the FoWS Committee, appointed at the AGM. All committee members are trustees of the charity and have control over FoWS, its property and funds. The roles and responsibilities of the Committee and committee members are set out in the FoWS Constitution.
