We are aware that many of you will be concerned about this global Pandemic and are therefore writing to update you with The Winchcombe School's latest response to Cronavirus, COVID-19. We want to assure you that we are taking the situation seriously with a strong focus on student and staff well-being.

In line with the Department for Education and Public Health England guidance we will keep parents informed about their current advice. The following key information is as follows:

At school we are being proactive in helping the children to understand, through assemblies about the importance of washing their hands and staff constantly reminding them to do so before break and lunch times. At the moment the guidance states that no school should close in response to a suspected (or confirmed) COVID-19 case unless they are told to do so by Public health England. We are however, preparing for the possibility of a school closure.
