We recognise that mobile phones have an important part to play in securing pupils' personal safety before and after school and on journeys to and from school. This means that some children in the upper end of the school bring a mobile phone in to school.

Following our review of procedures, if your child brings their mobile phone to school, please make sure you have read and signed the agreement attached and returned it to the school office.

All mobile phones must be switched off and handed in to the office at the beginning of the school day before children go to class. Mobile phones must be clearly named and will be kept safely in class boxes. Children will be able to collect their phones from the office after being dismissed.

As you will understand, the school is unable to take responsibility for any loss or damage to a mobile phone whilst the device is on the school premises and has not been handed in to the school office.
